



Pairing the Motorola 270c with the Motorola Bluetooth Headset

Pairing the Motorola 270c with the Motorola Bluetooth Headset

1. Make sure both the phone and headset are fully charged.
2. Verify that the Bluetooth Module is connected to the phone.
3. Turn on the phone.
4. Configuring the Motorola Phone



Press the *Menu* button on the phone to access the phone options.



From the initial menu screen, scroll down to *Settings*.



Press the *Right Soft Key* to select the *Settings* menu.



Scroll down to *Connection* and press the *Right Soft Key* to select.



Press the *Right Soft Key* to select *Bluetooth Link*.

*** If you don't see *Bluetooth Link*, take the module off, power the phone off and then reconnect the module and power the phone back on. Then repeat Step 4. ***



Press the *Right Soft Key* to select *Handsfree*.

5. Configuring the Motorola Bluetooth Headset.



With the boom closed on the headset, press and hold the *Multi-Function* button on the headset until the light on the boom turns solid blue.



After holding the *multi-function* button on the headset for two seconds, this light will turn solid blue.



Once the light is solid blue, open the boom on the headset.

*****On the 270 handset, scroll down to *Scan All*.*****
(You will want to set-up the headset before selecting *Scan All* because the handset times out after 15 seconds.)



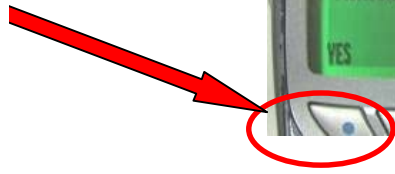
Press the *Right Soft Key* to select *Scan All*.



The phone will then go into *Scanning* mode to try to find the headset.



Press the *Left Soft Key* to select *Yes* to be able to initiate the bond with the headset.



The phone will then ask for a *Passkey*, which for the headset is always 0000. Enter 0000 into the phone.

Then press the *Right Soft Key* to select *OK*.



Once you enter the passkey, the phone will display the *Motorola Headset*. From here, press the *Right Soft Key* to select *Link*.



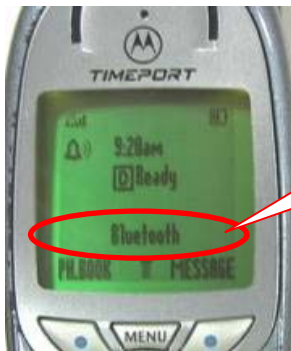


The phone will then display *Connecting* while it attempts to connect to the headset.

The phone will then display *Connected: Motorola Headset*.



Press the *End* button on the 270 handset to exit the Bluetooth menus.



Once connected, the phone will display *Bluetooth*.

6. From this point, you will be free to use the headset with your phone. When Bluetooth is displayed on the phone, all audio will go through the headset. You can control the phone calls from the phone itself or on the headset using the Multi-function button. To disconnect, all you need to do is close the boom on the headset.
The next time you want to connect, all you will need to do is have the phone powered on and open the boom on the headset and they will automatically find each other.
