12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit held in Cebu, Philippines from 10 to 15 January 2007



The secure radio and surveillance network used during the 12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit in Cebu, Philippines relied on Motorola's Trunked Radio technology and CANOPY<sup>®</sup> system.

## BACKGROUND

The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) was established on 8 August 1967 in Bangkok by the five member countries of Singapore, Philippines, Malaysia, Indonesia and Thailand. To date, it has expanded its membership count to ten.

The ASEAN Summit is the annual convention of all the Heads of State and Government from the ASEAN member countries to make important decisions with regard to economic and functional cooperation, political cooperation and external relations, among others.

The Philippine National Police (PNP) has been a long-time user of Motorola's solutions, and when the island city of Cebu in Philippines was set to host the 12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit held from 10 to 15 January 2007, Motorola was selected to deploy a secure radio and surveillance network.

## MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS

The radio network used by the Philippines National Police was deployed on Mount Busay as part of its continuing efforts towards a nationwide rollout. The deployment consisted of a five-channel trunked radio system using MTC 3600 Site Controller and ATS2500 subscriber handsets which all police personnel involved in securing the event were equipped with. Security forces were also mobilized around the city and in the conference venues during the four-day event.

In addition, a shared city-wide surveillance network was also installed with over 40 wireless Sony IP video cameras together with Motorola Canopy® 5.7GHz access points mounted on light poles covering the entire stretch of Cebu enabling continuous video surveillance throughout the Summit.
