You are always only one tap from the map, so you can quickly find helpful info when "choosing your own adventure," whether you are learning that the next rest stop is the last one for 90 miles or finding an old friend who lives in a new zip code so you never get lost in the device.

Simply dictate what you are looking for and MOTONAV finds the information for you.
