Retirement of PTP 58400 Wireless Ethernet Bridge

Intent for Retirement

The purpose of this notice is to communicate the retirement notice for the 400 Series Point-to-Point Wireless Ethernet Bridge for the 5.8 GHz spectrum (PTP 58400). The retirement of the PTP 58400 coincides with the release of the Point-to-Point 500 Series LITE and the Point-to-Point 300 Series radios (PTP 300). This notice does not impact the availability or support of the other 400 Series radios to include the 4.9 GHz (PTP 49400) and the 5.4 GHz radio (PTP 54400). The following conditions apply to the retirement of the PTP 58400:

- Motorola will continue to accept orders until October 7, 2008 on a first in, first out basis until current inventory is depleted.
- Motorola will continue to support the product for 5 years following the retirement of the PTP 58400.
- Motorola will continue to supply upgrades – LITE to FULL, AES and spares for a period of 5 years.
- Motorola will continue to support upgrades of PTP 400 LITE to FULL indefinitely via software key.
- In parallel with this retirement notice, regional promotions of the PTP 58400 will be arranged.

Reason for Retirement

In response to customer requests for new features, the PTP portfolio of wireless Ethernet bridges has been expanded to include the PTP 300 and the PTP 500 (FULL and LITE) solutions. While these products are based on the same combination of technologies that earned Motorola the number one market share in the point-to-point Ethernet bridge market, the PTP 300 and the PTP 500 families of products offer added features, throughput options and price points which are compatible with the PTP 400 and extend beyond the PTP 400's feature set. As a result, we are discontinuing the production of the PTP 58400 product and encourage our customers to migrate to the new PTP 300 and PTP 500 Series solutions. Going forward, our continued research and development efforts will bring to market even more product lines to serve an ever-growing number of customer requirements and market niches. The PTP 300 and 500 offer customers a number of advantages over the PTP 58400 Series radios to include the following:

- Lower cost per Mbps
- Up to 105 Mbps throughput
- Low latency < 2 ms
- Lightning protection built into ODU
- Analog output alignment aid
- Improved link budget
- Selectable 5/10/15 MHz channel
